### Sending money to Brazil – Some common problems:

- The Brazilian real is a restricted currency, so reals cannot be sent into Brazil. You must send a foreign currency to be converted upon arrival in the country – usually at a poor rate of exchange.
- Money sent to Brazil must be registered with the Central Bank of Brazil (Banco Central do Brasil). If it is not correctly registered, you may have complications when you come to repatriating funds.
- Transfers are often slow and securing a guaranteed delivery date can be difficult.
