

## **HOW TO GET THERE – FLIGHT INFO**

There are 4 international airports in Cape Verde. These are located on Sal, Santiago, Boa Vista and (shortly) Sao Vicente.

### **Flights to Sal**

UK – Sal (Gatwick, Manchester and Birmingham – Tui group)

Italy - Sal (Rome, Milan – Neos Air)

Germany – Sal (Dusseldorf – Tui group)

France - Sal (Paris)

Portugal – Sal (Lisbon – Tap airlines)

Norway – Sal (Tui Group)

### **Flights to Boa Vista**

UK – Boa Vista - Tui Group/Thompsons

Italy - Boa Vista

### **Flights to Santiago**

Amsterdam - Gran Canaria – Santiago (TACV)

Portugal – Santiago (Lisbon)

Angola - Santiago

Brazil – Santiago (Fortaleza – TACV)

USA – Santiago (Boston - TACV)

### **Inter- Island flights**

The longest internal flight to the other islands is 35 minutes. Book internal flights in advance – sometimes it is difficult to travel between islands at short notice (especially at peak times such as Easter, Christmas, New Year).

### **Arriving in Cape Verde**

**visa:** once you arrive in the international airports, you will need to obtain a visa. there is a small room by passport control which you must enter to apply for a visa. this currently costs 45 euros and lasts for 30 days. do not queue up in passport control without seeking your visa first. it is time consuming!
